MATH NOTEBOOK REQUIREMENTS/EVALUATION SHEET

Items needed for your math class:

- Three-ring Binder at least 1" thick
- Notebook Paper
- Scientific/Graphing Calculator
- Divider Tabs
- Straight edge, compass, protractor (if needed)

Your math notebook is to be kept daily and turned in at the **end of each quarter**. *You are responsible to have it in class and current for any notebook checks during the semester.* The second and fourth quarter notebooks are semester notebooks so you must keep the materials from the first and third quarters, respectively. Do not throw them away.

Place your name and subject neatly on the front cover of the notebook. Divide your notebook into *four sections*: **Notes, Assignments, Tests, and Quizzes**. The **Geometry** notebook will have three additional tabs: **Postulates, Theorems/Corollaries, and Constructions**. Use neatly labeled tab divider sheets to separate the sections. All sections are to be arranged chronologically. Each day's notes, test/quizzes and assignments are to be *dated in the upper right hand corner*, and each postulate and theorem/corollary is to be dated according to the date it was covered. The **Notes** section may be done in **pen** or **pencil** and is to be a continuing record of important points, procedures, and examples covered in class. The **Postulates and Theorems/Corollaries** section may also be done in **pen** or **pencil**. The **Assignments, Tests, and Quizzes** section are to be done in **pencil only**, except for corrections and comments, which are to be in **red pen only**. Each assignment is to include the *date, page number and problem numbers* in the upper right hand corner of the paper.

At the end of each quarter count **your** assignments and Tests/quizzes.
